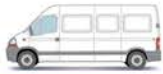

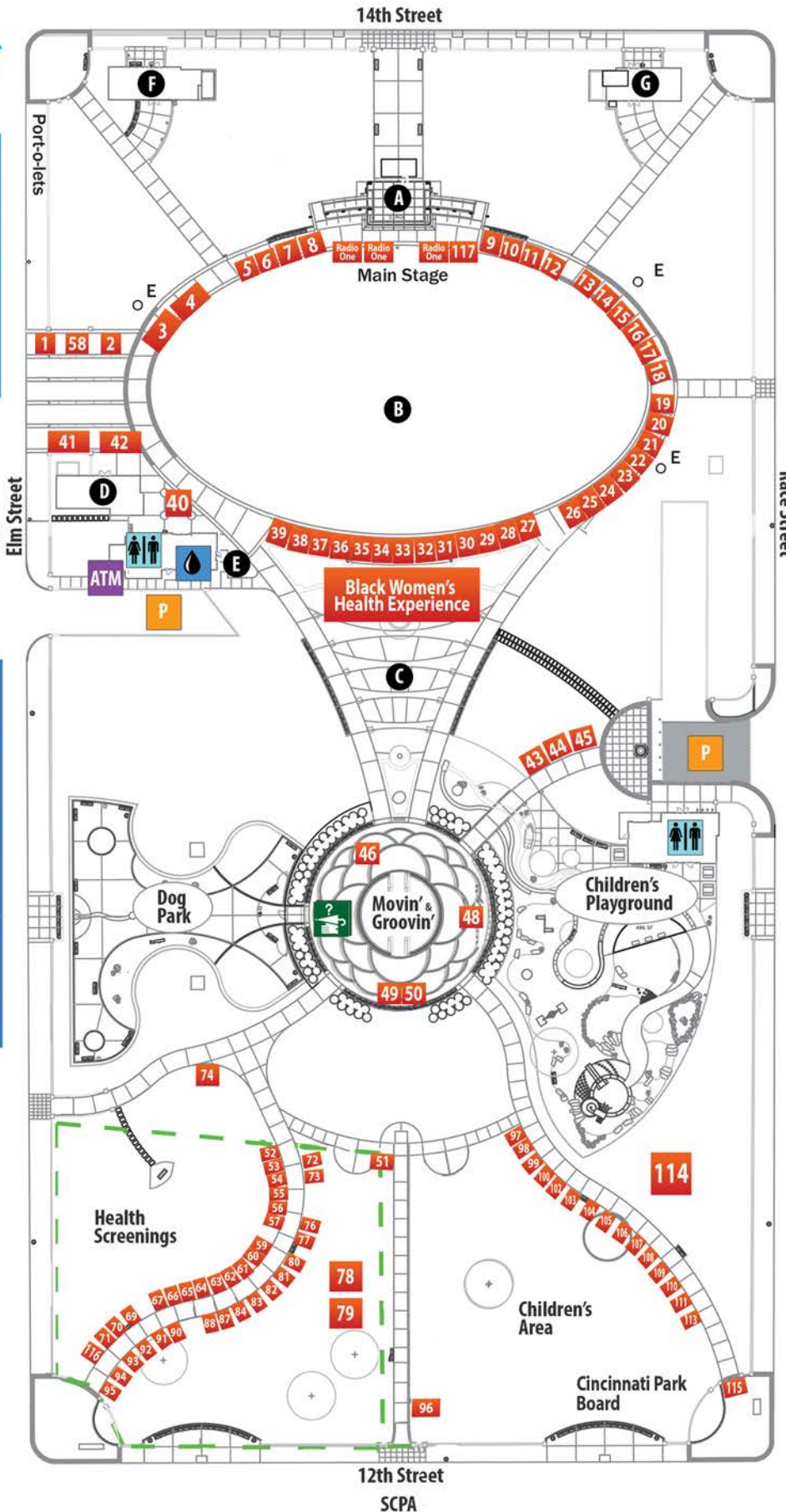

ORGAN DONATION ACROSS RACE & ETHNICITY

KIDNEY DISEASE

- 33% of all American adults are at risk for kidney disease
- Black/African Americans are 3-4 times more likely to progress to kidney failure compared to White Americans
- Hispanics/Latinos are 1.3 times more likely to progress to kidney failure compared to White Americans

WAITING LIST

- 30,400 (29%) people on the national transplant waiting list are Black/African American
- About 21,900 people on the national transplant waiting list are Hispanic/Latino
- More than 9,600 people on the national transplant waiting list are Asian/Pacific Islander

RECIPIENTS IN 2020

- 2,300 Asian/Pacific Islander organ transplant recipients
- 6,500 Hispanic/Latino organ transplant recipients
- 8,400 Black/African American organ transplant recipients

DONORS IN 2020

- 356 deceased and 261 living Asian/Pacific Islander donors
- 1,982 deceased and 390 living Black/African American donors
- 1,845 deceased and 831 living Hispanic/Latino donors

WHAT IS CKD

About 37 million American adults have chronic kidney disease (CKD) and most don't even know it. CKD includes conditions that damage your kidneys. The word "chronic" refers to the gradual, but lasting, loss of kidney function over time. Healthy kidneys remove the waste that your body naturally produces out of your blood. With unhealthy kidneys, you are unable to filter waste and excess fluid from your blood as well as you should.

CKD is not the same as kidney failure. CKD refers to all five stages of kidney disease, from mild loss of kidney function at stage 1 to complete kidney failure at stage 5.



More than **1** in **7**

15% of US adults are estimated to have chronic kidney disease—that is about 37 million people.



The stages of kidney disease is based on how well your kidneys are able to remove waste and excess fluid from your blood. In the early stages of kidney disease, many people don't have any symptoms.
